<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - went to the Mount of Olives - Garden of Gethsemane - Jesus was there with the 11 disciples - Jesus Prayer - that the cup be taken away - Your will be done not Mine - His disciples were sleeping - tells them His hour has come - Judas comes with a crowd with swords and clubs - Judas betrays Him with a kiss - Jesus says that I am He - and they all fall down - Peter cuts off Malchus' ear (Jesus heals the ear) - lead Jesus away - all of this is to fulfill Scripture - this was around midnight <p>John 18:1-12 Matthew 26:30-56 Mark 14:26-50 Luke 22:39-54</p>	<p>Annas - John 18:12-24</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - father-in-law to Caiaphas - questioned about His disciples and His teachings - ask those who heard Me speak - this was a night trial <p>Caiaphas - High priest</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - John 18:24 - Matthew 26:57-75; Mark 14:53-72 - Jesus was bound - Peter denies Jesus 2 more times (3 times total - cock crowed) - scribes and elders - trying to get false testimony - Jesus acknowledge that He was the Son of God - blasphemy - spit in His face and hit Him, beat Him <p>Sanhedrin</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mark 15:1; Luke 22:66-71 - early in the morning - Jesus is questioned and He tells them that they won't believe - He is the Son of God 	<p>Pilate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - John 18:28-38; Matt 27:11-14; Mark 15:2-5; Luke 23:1-5 - early morning the day of Passover - Jesus is accused of being an evildoer - Pilate asks if Jesus is the King of the Jews - Jesus wasn't answering the charges - Pilate is amazed - misleading the nation - forbidding to pay taxes - stirs up the people by His teaching - Pilate finds no guilt <p>Herod</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Luke 23:6-12 - Herod wanted to see the signs Jesus performed - He mocked Him and put a purple robe on Him and sent Him to Pilate <p>Pilate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - John 18:39-19:16; Matt 27:15-31; Mark 15:6-20; Luke 23:13-25 - The people could have prisoner released - Barabbas is released - Pilate had Jesus scourged - crown of thorns and purple robe, blows - Pilate washes his hands of this
