<ul> <li>went to the Mount of Olives</li> <li>Garden of Gethsemane</li> <li>Jesus was there with the 11 disciples</li> <li>Jesus Prayer</li> <li>that the cup be taken away</li> <li>Your will be done not Mine</li> <li>His disciples were sleeping</li> <li>tells them His hour has come</li> <li>Judas comes with a crowd with swords and clubs</li> <li>Judas betrays Him with a kiss</li> <li>Jesus says that I am He - and they all fall down</li> <li>Peter cuts off Malchus' ear (Jesus heals the ear)</li> <li>lead Jesus away</li> <li>all of this is to fulfill Scripture</li> <li>this was around midnight</li> <li>John 18:1-12</li> <li>Matthew 26:30-56</li> <li>Mark 14:26-50</li> <li>Luke 22:39-54</li> </ul>	Annas - John 18:12-24 - father-in-law to Caiaphas - questioned about His disciples and His teachings - ask those who heard Me speak - this was a night trial Caiaphas - High priest - John 18:24 - Matthew 26:57-75; Mark 14:53-72 - Jesus was bound - Peter denies Jesus 2 more times (3 times total - cock crowed) - scribes and elders - trying to get false testimony - Jesus acknowledge that He was the Son of God - blasphemy - spit in His face and hit Him, beat Him Sanhedrin - Mark 15:1; Luke 22:66-71 - early in the morning - Jesus is questioned and He tells them that they won't believe - He is the Son of God	<ul> <li>Pilate <ul> <li>John 18:28-38; Matt 27:11-14; Mark 15:2-5; Luke 23:1-5</li> <li>early morning the day of Passover</li> <li>Jesus is accused of being an evildoer</li> <li>Pilate asks if Jesus is the King of the Jews</li> <li>Jesus wasn't answering the charges</li> <li>Pilate is amazed</li> <li>misleading the nation</li> <li>forbidding to pay taxes</li> <li>stirs up the people by His teaching</li> <li>Pilate finds no guilt</li> </ul> </li> <li>Herod <ul> <li>Luke 23:6-12</li> <li>Herod wanted to see the signs Jesus performed</li> <li>He mocked Him and put a purple robe on Him and sent Him to Pilate</li> </ul> </li> <li>Pilate <ul> <li>John 18:39-19:16; Matt 27:15-31; Mark 15:6-20; Luke 23:13-25</li> <li>The people could have prisoner released</li> <li>Barabbas is released</li> <li>Pilate had Jesus scourged</li> <li>crown of thorns and purple robe, blows</li> <li>Pilate washes his hands of this</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
