<p>Ez 36:24-28</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God will take them from the nations and bring them to their land (24)</li> <li>- Sprinkle water on them and cleanse them (25)</li> <li>- New heart and new Spirit (26)</li> <li>- I will put My Spirit in you (27)</li> <li>- Cause them to walk in His statutes (27)</li> <li>- You will live in the land (28)</li> <li>- I will be your God and you will be My people (28)</li> <li>- They will live in the land forever (Ez 37:25)</li> </ul> <p>Ro 11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God has not rejected His people (1)</li> <li>- There is a remnant according to God's gracious choice (5)</li> <li>- Israel did not stumble so as to fall (11)</li> <li>- Fall = #G4098 - pipto = perish or be lost; come to an end, disappear, cease, to lose their authority, fail to participate in</li> <li>- Their transgression brought salvation to the Gentiles to make them jealous (11)</li> <li>- Partial hardening until the fullness of the Gentiles comes in (25)</li> <li>- Gifts and calling of God are irrevocable (28-29) = not able to be changed or reversed - they are final</li> </ul> <p>Jer 31:23-34</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- make a new covenant with the house of Israel and Judah (31)</li> <li>- Put His laws on their hearts (33)</li> <li>- He will be their God (34)</li> <li>- They will know God (34)</li> <li>- He won't remember their sins anymore (34)</li> <li>- Lord will not forget His people and Israel will not cease (35-37)</li> </ul>	<p>Hebrews 10:1-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Law = shadow/form of things to come (1)</li> <li>- Sacrifices couldn't make men perfect (2-3)</li> <li>- Impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sin (4)</li> <li>- Jesus takes away the first (covenant of law) to establish the second (covenant of grace) (9)</li> <li>- He died once for all (10)</li> <li>- Jesus sat down (work was finished) at the right hand of God - until His enemies become His footstool (12-13)</li> <li>- By one offering He perfected for all time those who are sanctified (14)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Holy Spirit was given and it bears witness to us</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- God's law is now on their hearts</li> <li>- Written on our minds</li> <li>- Sins and lawless deeds I will remember no more (15-17)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Result</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- where there is forgiveness - there is no need for sin offering anymore (18)</li> <li>- Ro 12:1-2 - living sacrifice - by staying clear of the world and allowing God to transform our minds through His Word</li> </ul> <p><b><u>What will show in our lives?</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Confidence to enter God's presence (19-20)</li> <li>- We have a great priest (21)</li> <li>- Draw near to God (22)</li> <li>- Hearts sprinkled clean, bodies washed (22)</li> <li>- We will exhibit the fruit of the Spirit (Gal 5:22-23)</li> </ul>

<p>Prophetic Overview - Fulfilled</p> <p>Festival of Passover</p> <p><b><u>Passover</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- killed the lamb - blood on the doorposts (Ex 12:1-13)</li> <li>- 1st month - 14th day at twilight (Lev 23:6-8)</li> <li>- Christ was our Passover Lamb (I Cor 5:7)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Unleavened Bread</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- rid the house of leaven (sin) (Ex 12:14-20)</li> <li>- 1st month 15th day for 7 days (Lev 23:6-8)</li> <li>- His death (burial, resurrection) cleansed us from sin (I Cor 5:7-8)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Feast of Firstfruits</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- promise of the harvest to come (Lev 23:9-14)</li> <li>- Day after the Sabbath (Sunday)</li> <li>- Christ was raised on Firstfruits (I Cor 15:20-24)</li> </ul> <p>Start counting the Omer (50 days)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Jn 16:7 - promise of the coming of the Holy Spirit</li> <li>- Acts 1:1-3 - Jesus stayed with them for 40 days</li> <li>- Acts 1:9-26 - they returned to Jerusalem - 10 days - the remainder of the time of counting the Omer</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Festival of Pentecost</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 50 days after first fruits (Lev 23:15-21)</li> <li>- Gathering of harvest - bring 2 loaves of bread (17)</li> <li>- Jew and Gentile together - Spirit of Promise - one body</li> <li>- Acts 2:1-47 - the Spirit came on Pentecost to any who believed</li> <li>- Acts 10 - Gift of the Spirit was for Jew and Gentile as well (45)</li> <li>- I Cor 12:13 - on Spirit and we are part of one body - Jew and Gentile</li> <li>- Eph 2:11-3:7 - Jew and Gentile make up the church of God</li> </ul>	<p>Prophetic Overview - Yet to be fulfilled</p> <p>Feast of Tabernacles</p> <p><b><u>Feast of Trumpets</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- gathering together for a holy convocation (Lev 23:23-25)</li> <li>- 7th month, 1st of the month - blowing of trumpets</li> <li>- Regathering of Israel (Ez 36:24)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Day of Atonement</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- making atonement to cleanse from sin (Lev 16:30)</li> <li>- 10th day of the 7th month (Lev 23:26-32)</li> <li>- Humbling the people (Lev 23:27, 29, 32)</li> <li>- Israel will repent - in one day (Zech 3:9; 12; 13; 14:9)</li> <li>- Ez 36:25-27 - they would have clean water sprinkled on them</li> <li>- Heb 9-10 - replacing the Old Covenant with the New</li> <li>- Ro 11:25-29 - partial hardening for a time</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Feast of Tabernacles</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- harvest celebration - memorial of the tabernacle in the wilderness</li> <li>- 15th day of the 7th month lasts for 8 days (Lev 23:33-36, 39-43)</li> <li>- Time of dwelling with the people - families will gather to Jerusalem to celebrate (Zech 14:16-19; Ez 36:28; Rev 21:1-)</li> </ul>
