| <p>Rev 7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bondservants of God (3) - Jews - 12,000 from every tribe (5-8) - Sealed on foreheads - Locusts were not allowed to harm the men who had the seal on the foreheads (9:4) <p>Rev 14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they had the names of God and Jesus on their forehead - Standing with Jesus - They sing a new song before God's throne in heaven - Purchased from the earth - redeemed - They were not defiled by women - chaste - They follow the Lamb wherever He goes - Firstfruits from among men to God and to the Lamb - No lie in their mouth - blameless <p>Sealed after the 6th seal on earth Taken to heaven at 7th trumpet</p> | <p>Rev 11</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus' witnesses (3) - 2 olive trees and 2 lamp stands that stood before the Lord of the earth (4) - Tormented people by telling truth - when they tried to stop them - they killed them (5-6) - Withhold rain, other plagues that they could bring - 1,260 days = 3 1/2 years (3) - Beast coming out of the abyss killed them - People of the earth celebrated - until they stood up and were taken into heaven (11-12) - Earthquake, 1/10 of city fell, 7,000 people killed (13) - There were those who gave glory to God (Lk 17:18-19; Zech 12:10; 13:1, 8-9; Rom 11:25-27) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - olive trees and lamp stands (Zech 4) - Lamp like in the tabernacle - it has a never ending source of oil (trees) with spouts feeding the lamps that would never go out - Zerubbabel - descendant of David - kingly line - Joshua - descendant of Eleazar - priestly line - Zech 6:13 - Ps 110 - king and the high priest together - picture of Jesus - source of blessing and light to the world <p>Who are they? Elijah and Moses (Malachi 4:5-6) Elijah and Enoch (He 9:27)</p> |

| <p>Mystery = #G3466 - musterion - secret doctrine - root word #G3453 - mueo - shut the eyes and mouth</p> <p>Rev 10:7 - mystery of God is finished as was preached to His servants (7th trumpet) Is finished = aorist indicative passive verb = summary without reference to the time period or how it unfolds</p> <p>Rev 11:15-19 (7th trumpet) - the kingdom of the world will be become the kingdom of our Lord and His Christ - He will rule forever - Nations were enraged - because God's wrath is coming</p> <p>7th trumpet finishes the mystery of God - unveils His wrath Rev 15:1 - 7 bowls - 7 plagues - they are the last - the wrath of God is finished</p> <p>Wrath = 14:10; 15:1, 7; 16:1, 19</p> <p>Rev 19:15 - Jesus treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God</p> | <p>Rev 14:14-20 - putting the sickle in and reaping - Clusters gathered and put into the wine press of the great wrath of God - Wine press was trodden outside the city - up to the horse's bridle for a distance of 200 miles</p> <p>Rev 16:12-16 - Euphrates dried up - Armies are gathered to a place called Armageddon</p> <p>Rev 19:11-21 - white horse comes - Jesus - sword in His mouth - Army following on white horses - Strike down the nations - Tread the wine press of the fierce wrath of God - Beast and false prophet thrown into the Lake of Fire</p> <p>Zech 12-14 Is 34-35 - the slaughter of Edom Is 63:1-6 Hab 3:3-15 Jer 49:13-22 Dan 11:41 Joel 2:30-3:21 Zech 14:1-15</p> |
