Rev 10:7 - mystery of God is finished as was preached to His servants (7th trumpet) Is finished = aorist indicative passive verb = summary without reference to the time period or how it unfolds	
Rev 11:15-19 (7th trumpet) - the kingdom of the world will be become the kingdom of our Lord and His Christ - He will rule forever - Nations were enraged - because God's wrath is coming	
7th trumpet finishes the mystery of God - unveils His wrath Rev 15:1 - 7 bowls - 7 plagues - they are the last - the wrath of God is finished	
Wrath = 14:10; 15:1, 7; 16:1, 19	
Rev 19:15 - Jesus treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God
