1. Nisan 10 - Lamb Selection Day - selecting the Passover Lamb - Lambs paraded into the temple - Passover Lamb to live among the house and be examined for four days - As the lambs were paraded into the city - Jesus came riding into the city on a donkey
2. Nisan 11 - Jesus goes into the temple and drives out the money changers - He foretells of His crucifixion
3. Nisan 12 - Jesus' authority questioned
4. Nisan 13 - Jesus' feet anointed (for His burial) - Judas agrees to betray Jesus
5. Nisan 14 - Sunset begins Passover - Jesus has the last supper with His disciples in the upper room
6. Judas leaves and Jesus and rest of the disciples go to the Gethsemane - Jesus prays for the cup to be taken from Him while the disciples sleep - Judas comes to betray Jesus - He is arrested
7. Illegal night trials - Before Annas, Caiaphas, Sanhedrin, Pilate, Herod
8. Peter denies Christ three times before the cock crows
9. Jesus brought before Pilate again in the morning
10. Jesus scourged and mocked - taken to be crucified - 9 AM - 3rd hour (hours starting a 6 AM)
11. Darkness covered earth from noon to 3PM (6th-9th hour) - when the priests would have been preparing for sacrifices
12. Jesus died the at 3PM when the Passover Lamb was killed - curtain torn in temple from top to bottom
13. Permission sought to take the body off the cross and bury it before the High Sabbath
14. Feast of Unleavened bread (High Sabbath) begins at sundown on Nisan 15
15. Nisan 16 - the woman buy and prepare the spices to take to the tomb
16. Nisan 17 - weekly Sabbath - a day of rest
17. Jesus rises from the dead after three full days and three full nights in the tomb
18. Woman come to the tomb and find it empty

13. Permission sought to take the body off the cross and bury it before the High Sabbath (this day being counted as one day - even though there is just a very small part of the day accounted for - since He was crucified and died that day it is all classified as the first day in the tomb)
14. Feast of Unleavened bread (High Sabbath) begins at sundown on Nisan 15
15. Two Sabbaths explaining why Sabbath in Matthew
16. Jesus rises from the dead after three days and three nights in the tomb
17. Woman come to the tomb and find it empty

There is no day for the women to buy and prepare the spices to take to the tomb - Luke 23:55-56
