<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - spring was time for military battle (1) - Joab - hired fighters and Israel's army (1) - David stayed home instead of going into battle (1) - Bathsheba - daughter of Eliam - one of David's mighty men (3) - Grandfather of Bathsheba Ahithophel (15:12; 16:15) - David's counselor - Uriah - one of David's mighty men = Uriah was a Hittite - Heb name = the Lord is my Light - David makes desperate attempts to get Uriah to go to his home with his wife (6-13) - David writes Uriah's death instructions and sends them to Joab by Uriah's hand and he has Uriah killed (14-21) - David takes Bathsheba to be his wife (26-27) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Nathan confronts David of his sin (1) - He uses the example of a rich taking the one and only precious sheep from a poor man and killing it (1-4) - David's anger burned against this man who took another man's sheep - he deserves to die (5) - he had no compassion (6) - Nathan tells David you are this man (7) - God has given to David - kingdom, deliverance, Saul's kingdom, united kingdom - He would have added many more things (8) - Why have you despised the word of the Lord by doing evil (9) <p>Consequences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sword will never depart from your house (10) - Evil will come from within your own house (11) - I will take your wives from you and give them to another - God will make David's sin and punishment known to all Israel (12) <p>David's response - I have sinned (13) The Lord has taken away your sin - you shall not die</p> <p>Consequences will be severe - so the nations will not blaspheme the Lord (14) The child that is born to you will surely die (14)</p>
