<p>Gen 12:1-3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - land (Canaan = Israel) - Great nation (Jews) - In you all the families of the earth will be blessed <p>Gen 13:15-16</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - descendants like the dust of the earth - This land will be Israel's forever! <p>Gen 15</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they will be enslaved for 400 years (13-14) - You will come out with many possessions <p>Gen 17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - father of a multitude of nations (4) - Name was changed (covenant) - God would be their God forever (7) - Land is an everlasting possession (8) - Promised covenant is passed through to Isaac (17-19) <p>Gen 48:4 - covenant promises are passed on to Jacob (Israel)</p> <p>Ex 32:13 - promise is passed to the people that Moses is leading</p> <p>Dt 28:58-68 - if they disobey - God will rip them out of their land</p>	<p>Jeremiah 7</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they put their trust in the temple (4) - Did not heed God's Word (24) - Did not obey God's command - Trusted in deceptive words (8) - Offered to Baal (9) - Walked after other gods (9) - Walked in their own counsel (24) - Walked in stubbornness (24) - Stiffened their necks (26) - Did not listen to the Lord or accept correction (28-29) - Didn't know truth anymore (28) - Building high places and sacrificing their children (30-31) 	<p>Kings of Israel</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Saul - 40 yrs - David - 40 yrs - Solomon - 40 yrs <p>Divided Kingdom - 931 BC</p> <p>North - Israel (Ephraim)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 10 tribes - Capital - Samaria <p>South - Judah</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 tribes - Jerusalem <p>722 BC - north taken captive by Assyria</p> <p>605-586 BC - south taken captive by Babylon (Nebuchadnezzar)</p> <p>Jer 25:1-14 - because they did not obey God, He sent Neb to the land and it became a horror and they were slaves in Babylon for 70 years</p> <p>People did come back under Ezra to rebuild the temple - later under Nehemiah to rebuild the walls</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - when they call all these things to mind and return to the Lord and obey - God will gather them together and restore them to their land (1-5) - Prosper them (5) - God will circumcise their heart - remove the heart of flesh and give them a clean heart (6) - God will take vengeance on those who persecuted them (7) - God will rejoice over them for good (9) 	<p>Prophecy to the land (1)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bear fruit (8) - God will cause Israel to possess the land of their enemies (12) - They will not bear disgrace any longer (15) - God judged the people and took them from their land (19) - The people profaned God's name (20-23) - For His holy name, He would bring the people back to their land (24) - God will sprinkle water on them to cleanse them from their filthy idols (25) - Give them a new heart (26) - Put His Spirit in them and cause them to walk in His ways (27-28) - They will not have famine (30) - THEN THEY WILL KNOW THAT I AM GOD (38) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dry bones = Israel (Judah) - God will bring the house back into their land and breathe life into them again (13) - They will know that He is God - Israel and all the nations (14) - 2 kingdoms becoming one nation with one king (19-24) - They will have their land, God's sanctuary will be there, He will be their God, and they will be His people forever (26)
