<p>Signs of the beginning</p> <p>2:3 - apostasy comes first, man of lawlessness is revealed</p> <p>2:7 - restrainer is going to be taken away</p> <p>Then the day of the Lord Lawless one is coming in accordance to the power of Satan</p> <p>Lord will slay him by His breath</p> <p>The Day of the Lord will come after the lawless one is revealed</p>	<p>Day of Pentecost Peter is speaking everyone thought they were drunk</p> <p>these men were filled with the Spirit</p> <p>How is the day described 2:19 - blood, fire, smoke</p> <p>When is that day? sun darkened moon turned to blood before the Day of the Lord</p> <p>After seal #6, after trumpet #4</p>	<p>Catching up of the saints (rapture)</p> <p>How is that day going to come</p> <p>5:2 - will come like a thief in the night to those who are in darkness</p> <p>5:3 - they will peace and safety - sudden destruction</p> <p>5:4 - you are not of the darkness that that day will overtake you</p> <p>5:5 - sons of light</p> <p>5:6 - be alert and sober</p> <p>5:9 - we are not destined for the wrath of God</p> <p>After the proclamation of peace and safety then destruction will come</p>	<p>4-6 - evil men say that all things keep going like it did from creation until now - nothing changes - they don't acknowledge the flood</p> <p>7 - the present earth and heavens are going to be destroyed by fire</p> <p>8-9 - time means nothing to God - He is not slow - He is patient - doesn't want anyone to perish but all to repent</p> <p>10-13 - the Day of the Lord will takes to the earth being destroyed and the New Heaven and the New Earth being made where righteousness dwells</p>

<p>825-809 BC - before the Assyrian captivity</p> <p>1:15 - the Day of the Lord is near, destruction from the Almighty</p> <p>2:2 - darkness, gloom, thick clouds</p> <p>2:11 - great and awesome - who can endure it?</p> <p>2:19 - at the end - Israel will never again be a reproach</p> <p>2:23-32 - sun darkened, moon like blood, come before the day of the Lord - whoever calls on the name of the Lord will be saved</p> <p>3:1 - Judah's fortunes restored</p> <p>3:2 - Lord would bring judgment against the nations</p> <p>3:9-17 - winepress is full and will be tread - earth will tremble - Lord will dwell in Zion (Is 2:4 compared Joel 3:10)</p>	<p>841-825 BC - written before Joel</p> <p>1-14 - vision concerning Edom - brought because of the violence done to Jacob (Num 20:14-21)</p> <p>15 - the Day of the Lord draws near on the nations</p> <p>16 - all nations will become like they never existed</p> <p>17 - Mt Zion will become a refuge - Jacob will possess their possessions</p> <p>18 - no survivor left in the house of Esau (Is 63:1-6)</p> <p>21 - the kingdom will be the Lord's (Rev 11:15)</p>	<p>787-755 BC - prophesying to Israel before their captivity</p> <p>Call to Repentance</p> <p>1 - dirge (funeral song) - to the house of Israel</p> <p>4 - God calls them to seek Him and live</p> <p>5-7 - they seek others to rescue them</p> <p>18 - Israel is longing for the Day of the Lord because they think they will be rescued and restored</p> <p>Description</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- it will be darkness not light</li> <li>- No place of escape</li> <li>- Day of gloom with no brightness</li> </ul>	<p>739-681 - before and during the Assyrian captivity</p> <p>1 - Babylon</p> <p>6 - wail - destruction from the Almighty</p> <p>7 - great fear</p> <p>9 - cruel with fury and burning anger - become a desolation</p> <p>10 - stars, sun, moon will be dark</p> <p>11 - God will punish wickedness</p> <p>12 - men are going to die in great numbers</p> <p>13 - heavens trembling - burning anger</p> <p>19 - complete destruction</p> <p>20 - never be inhabited again</p>

<p>636-623 BC - speaking to Judah before Babylonian captivity</p> <p>1:4 - God's hand is stretched against Judah            1:7 - day of the Lord is near            1:12 - God will punish men with stagnant spirits            1:15 - day of wrath, trouble, distress            1:16 - trumpet and battle            1:17 - distress because of their sin against God            1:18 - nothing will deliver them            2:2 - Day of the Lord's anger            2:7 - day that Israel's fortunes will be restored            3:6 - cities of nations are laid waste            3:8 - indignation will be poured out on the nations            3:11 - God will remove the proud            3:12-13 - humble remnant will be left            13:15 - Lord will be in their midst            13:19 - God will deal with their oppressors and restore their fortunes (20)</p>	<p>592-559 BC - during the Babylonian captivity</p> <p>Ez 13            2 - prophets were prophesying from their own hearts            3 - they have seen nothing            4-9 - the Lord is against the false prophets            10 - misleading the people and giving false hope</p> <p>Ez 30            2-3 - wail - day of clouds and doom to the nations            4 - Egypt will fall            6-7 - those who support Egypt will fall            9 - anguish will come from Ethiopia</p>	<p>520-489 BC - after the Babylonian captivity</p> <p>1-5 - nations will gather against Jerusalem - Lord will fight the nations - His feet standing on the Mt of Olives - it will split in half</p> <p>6 - luminaries will dwindle</p> <p>8 - living waters will flow out of Jerusalem</p> <p>9 - Lord will be King over all the earth</p> <p>12-15 - battle against Jerusalem after the 1,000 years</p> <p>20-21 - everyone will be holy to the Lord in that day</p>	<p>435-415 BC</p> <p>3:2-4 - God will purify the sons of Levi so they can make a peace offering to Him</p> <p>3:4-7 - God will bring judgment on them</p> <p>8-18 - after all they have been through - they still do not know God to serve Him</p> <p>4:5 - Before the Day of the Lord God will send Elijah</p>
