Interpretations	Rev 1:7	Acts	Romans 11:1-29
<p>Preterism - past</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - believe that prophecies have already taken place - Christians are reigning as kings with Christ on the earth <p>Historicism - present</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the church right now is the tribulation and Daniel's 70th week - 1,260 days = they think those are years - began with the Roman Catholic Church <p>Futurism - future</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - events in Rev 6-19 and Daniel's 70th week are yet to be fulfilled - Take the literal meaning of the Bible <p>Idealism - timeless</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - timing isn't important or knowable - Look for principles that we can live by 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - He is coming in the clouds - Every eye will see Him - Even those who pierced Him (Jews) - All the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him <p>SO - Israel, as a nation will see Him when He comes again</p>	<p>Acts 2:22-24 - Men of Israel - you nailed Jesus to the cross by handing Him over to the godless men (Romans)</p> <p>Acts 3:12-17 - the Jews disowned Jesus and delivered Him to death while requesting a murderer to be released in their presence</p> <p>Acts 4:1-2, 8-11 - people of Israel rejected and crucified Jesus</p> <p>Israel is the one who pierced Jesus</p>	<p>1-2 - God has not reject Israel</p> <p>5 - there is a remnant</p> <p>11 - they didn't stumble as to fall - by their transgression salvation has come to the Gentiles</p> <p>12 - there will be a fulfillment for the Jews</p> <p>23 - if they do not continue in the unbelief, they will be grafted in</p> <p>25 - partial hardening has happened until the fulness of the Gentiles has come in</p> <p>26 - thus all Israel will be saved</p> <p>26-27 - Israel will be saved by their deliverer</p> <p>29 - the gifts and calling of God are irrevocable</p>

<p>Rev 7:1-8 - 144,000 sealed - every tribe of Israel Dan - Judges 18:1-31; I Kings 12:25-33; Gen 49:17; Dt 33:22; Jer 8:16 (antichrist?), II Chr 2:14; I Chron 4-7 Manasseh - Gen 48:8-22; Num 1:32-33</p> <p>Rev 11:1-2 - there will be a temple 3 - 2 witnesses will prophecy 3 1/2 years 7-11 - the beast kills the prophets - and the earth quakes in Jerusalem</p> <p>Rev 12:6, 14 - woman (Israel) will be nourished in the wilderness for 3 1/2 years</p> <p>17 - dragon comes after the woman he goes after the rest of her offspring</p>	<p>15 - abomination of desolation being set up in the Holy Place - Daniel's people (Jews) and the Holy City (Jerusalem)</p> <p>16 - let those in Judea flee</p> <p>20 - pray your flight not be on the Sabbath</p> <p>21 - there will be a time of great tribulation</p> <p>30 - all the tribes of the earth will mourn - they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds</p> <p>31 - the elect are gathered from the 4 winds</p> <p>Israel will be on earth as a nation at this time</p>	<p>36:24; 37:21 - God will gather all of Israel from all the lands and bring them into their own land</p> <p>36:25-27; 37:23 - God will cleanse them and give them a new heart and put His Spirit in them and cause them to walk in His ways</p> <p>36:28, 37:23, 27 - I will be their God and they will be my people</p> <p>37:21-22 - God will make them one nation under one king</p> <p>37:24 - David (Jesus) will be king over them</p> <p>37:25 - Israel will live on the land forever - David will be their prince</p> <p>37:26, 28 - God will set His sanctuary in their midst forever</p>	<p>12:9 - In that day God will destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem (Rev 19)</p> <p>12:10 - God will pour out on Israel the Spirit of grace and supplication - they will look on Jesus whom they pierced and mourn</p> <p>13:8-9 - 2/3 of Israel will be cut off and perish, but 1/3 will be saved - they will call on His name</p> <p>14:2 - nations are gathered against Jerusalem to battle - city is captured (Rev 19)</p> <p>14:3 - The Lord will go forth in battle (Rev 19)</p> <p>14:5 - The Lord will come with His holy ones (Rev 19)</p> <p>14:9 - The Lord will be King over all the earth (Rev 20)</p> <p>14:16 - nations will be left and will come to Jerusalem to worship the King at the Feast of Booths</p>
