Betrayal/Unfaithfulness	Servanthood/Faithfulness	Jesus' Teaching
<p>Judas - betrayer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus chose him to fulfill Scripture - he was a thief and a liar - he did not care for the poor - Satan entered - Devil already put into his heart to betray Jesus - Acts 1:23-25 - Judas turned aside - I John 2:19 - those who are part of the group will stay with the group - if they leave they were never part of them - Col 1:21-23 - you have been reconciled if you remain faithful - he was sorry after he betrayed Jesus - II Cor 7:10-11 - godly sorrow and a worldly sorrow - one leads to eternal life, the other to death <p>Peter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - would lay down his life for Jesus (so he thought) - Jesus tells him he will deny him 3 times before the cock crows 	<p>Jesus knew His time was short (1)</p> <p>lays aside garments and girds Himself with a towel (4)</p> <p>Washed the disciples feet (5)</p> <p>Peter quickly tells Jesus that He is not to wash his feet (6, 8)</p> <p>Peter needed to realize that he could not cleanse himself - he needed to be washed by Jesus (8)</p> <p>Jesus gave them an example to follow - they are to wash one another's feet - humble ourselves before each other (14, 15)</p> <p>Love one another - by this all men will know you are My disciples (34-35)</p>	<p>One of them will betray Him (21)</p> <p>The one whom I give the morsel to - that is the betrayer (26)</p> <p>Jesus says to Judas do what you are going to do quickly (27)</p> <p>JUDAS LEAVES THE BUILDING! (30)</p>
