

Lesson 28 - Chapter 20 - The Resurrection

Resurrection	Appearances	Prophecy
<p>Mary and Mary bought spices to anoint Jesus after the Sabbath (Mark 16:1) - they prepared the spices (Luke 24:1)</p> <p>First day of the week (Sunday) as it began to dawn - they came to look at the grave (Mt 28:1) - Who is going to move the stone? (Mark 16:3)</p> <p>earthquake - an angel rolled away the stone and sat on it (Mt 28:2)</p> <p>There was no body in the tomb (Luke 24:3)</p> <p>angels appear (2?) fear not, why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, He has risen as He said He would (Mt 28:5-8; Mk 16:5-8; Lk 24:4-8)</p> <p>The women fled (Mk 16:8)</p> <p>Guards shook with fear and fell as dead men (Mt 28:4)</p> <p>The women go back to tell the disciples and the others (Lk 24:9-12)</p> <p>Most of the disciples didn't believe them</p> <p>Peter and John run for the tomb (Jn 20:2-10) saw the linen - no body - went home</p>	<p>Mary Magdalene - encounters Jesus at the tomb</p> <p>Jesus says that He will ascend to the Father and she was to go back (Jn 20:11-18)</p> <p>Mary tells the disciples that she talked to the Lord</p> <p>The brethren were to go to Galilee and Jesus would meet them there (Mt 28:9-10)</p> <p>Guards are bribed to say that the disciples came and stole the body while they were asleep (Mt 28:11-15)</p> <p>Jesus appears to the two men on their way to Emmaus (Lk 24:13-32)</p> <p>Mark 16:14 - Jesus reproached the disciples for not believing those who had seen Him</p> <p>Jesus shows them His wounds (Luke 24:36-43)</p> <p>Thomas won't believe unless he touches Him (John 20:19-25)</p> <p>Thomas touched Jesus (John 20:26-29)</p>	<p>I Cor 15:1-22 - what the gospel is</p> <p>Mark 8:31 - elders, chief priests, and scribes turned Him over, killed, raised on the 3rd day (9:31-32)</p> <p>Matthew 16:21 - He would go to Jerusalem - then be killed</p> <p>John 2:18-22 - the temple would be raised in 3 days</p> <p>Rom 4:22-25 - Jesus was put to death for our transgressions and raised up for our justification</p> <p>Rom 6:4-11 - baptized into His death - taking our identity from Him</p> <p>I John 3:2 - we will be like Him when we are resurrected from the dead</p>
