## David's Troubles - II Samuel 12:15b-24

Absalom's Rebellion (14-15)
<ul> <li>Chapt 14</li> <li>David is confronted by a woman from Tekoa</li> <li>Joab had brought her there and told her what to say (just as Nathan brought his message to David)</li> <li>David saw that he had the power/authority to change the law of the blood avengerer</li> <li>After mourning Absalom for 3 years, David allows Absalom to be brought back to Jerusalem but doesn't see him for 2 years</li> <li>Since Joab won't come to him when he calls, his servants set Joab's fields on fire to get his attention</li> <li>Absalom demands to see David</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Chapt 15</li> <li>Absalom starts stealing away the people of Israel telling them that David doesn't care about them but if he were judge he would take care of them</li> <li>Stole away the hearts of the people</li> <li>Through a series of lies, he gets David blessing to go to Hebron (1-6)</li> <li>He sets up his own kingdom in Hebron (7-12)</li> <li>David is on the run again - this time from Absalom (13-23)</li> <li>Zadok brings the ark of the covenant to David who tells him to return it to the city and the tent (24-29)</li> <li>God is his protection, not the ark</li> <li>David sends a trusted counselor, Hushai, back to Jerusalem to thwart the counsel of Ahithophel and bring word back to David (30-37)</li> <li>Absalom sets up his kingdom in Jerusalem</li> </ul>
