<p>Covenant for Abraham and his descendants (Israelites)</p> <p>Gen 17 - call for circumcision - obedience that was immediate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Cutting covenant - shedding of blood - Close to the source of paternity <p>Gen 22:1-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - confidence that God would keep His word - I and the lad will be back - Had a promise - through Isaac would come his descendants - Heb 11:17-19 - even if he had killed Isaac God could raise him back to life - Lk 14:26 - the test was Abraham's willing to put everything he had in God's hands and trust Him with it <p>Undying trust in God - God was in complete control - God keeps His Word (promises)</p>	<p>Ex 4:18-26</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - did not wholeheartedly keep the covenant of the Lord - Did not circumcise his son - God was going to put him to death <p>God demands to be honored, obeyed, respected, treated as holy - especially by the leaders - lead by example</p> <p>James 3:1 - teachers will incur a stricter judgment</p> <p>God doesn't want a leader who will not obey him completely</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Num 20:12 - Moses did not treat God as holy - Dt 32:51-52 - 1 Sam 15 - to obey is better than sacrifice <p>Treat God as holy in the sight of all people Leadership demands integrity</p>
