| <p>1-23</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jonathan and David make a covenant together - Jonathan will protect David and David is to show lovingkindness to Jonathan's house - Plan for whether Saul has intentions to kill David for David to flee <p>24-34</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Saul is angry at David for not appearing - He tries to kill Jonathan because he is helping David - Jonathan goes to warn David <p>35-42</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jonathan tells David to run - They say goodbye and leave | <p>David comes to Ahimelech at Nob</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David says that he is there on behalf of the king - Sin can never be blessed there will be consequences - Asks for food (Mt 12:1-7) - Asks for weapons and is given Goliath's sword <p>David comes to Achish king of Gath</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David acts as though insane - He feared Achish - Ps 34, 56 <p>David goes to the cave of Adullum</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - gathers a group of 400 men - David seeks asylum for his family in Moab (Ruth) - David leaves the stronghold - Saul tells all those around him that David is trying to kill him - Doeg tells Saul that Ahimelech helped David by giving him food and Goliath's sword - Saul wants Ahimelech killed - Doeg kills 85 priests that day and then turn on Nob - Abiathar escapes and flees to David - Ps 52 | <p>23:1-14</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David goes to Keilah to defeat the Philistines who were threatening it - He defeats the Philistines but flees the city before the people turn him over to Saul - David flees to the wilderness of Ziph <p>15-29</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The people of Ziph report to Saul on David's whereabouts - Saul sets out after him - but God protects him by bringing a Philistine raid - David heads for the Engedi <p>24:1-22</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David had the opportunity to kill Saul when he came into the cave where David and his men were hiding - The men wanted David to kill Saul - David would not touch the Lord's anointed - Saul acknowledges David's righteousness and his own wickedness | <p>25:1 - Samuel dies</p> <p>2-17</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Nabal's men speak kindly of David - Nabal refuses to help David and his men - David prepares for battle against Nabal - Men run to tell Abigail <p>18-38</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Abigail goes to David and begs forgiveness for her husband - Asks him to forgive for his own sake - God strikes Nabal dead <p>39-44</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David takes Abigail and Ahinoam as his wives - Saul gives Michal, David's wife, to someone else <p>26:1-25</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Saul was spared once again by David - Saul was "protected" by his army while David came into camp and took his spear and water jug - Saul admits his sin and says he will stop hunting David |

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David turns to the Philistines so that Saul will not continue to pursue him - He goes to Achish in Gath - He is given the city of Ziklag to live in - David goes to Shur (part of the Promised Land) and kills the enemies there - When questioned by Achish - David said he went against the Negev of Judah - Achish comes to the conclusion that David was going after his own people and now Israel would hate David | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Saul goes to a medium (which wasn't supposed to be there) to ask her to conjure up Samuel so he could seek advice - Samuel appeared and was recognizable to both the medium and Saul - They will not win the battle and tomorrow you and your sons will be dead - Saul was greatly afraid | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - David was told to go back to Ziklag because the Philistine lords did not trust him - Achish encourages him to go but finds no fault in David - Upon return to Ziklag, they found the city burned all the possessions stolen and the wives and children gone - David goes after them and recovers all that was taken plus more - David sent gifts to the surrounding cities | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The battle against Israel rages - Saul is shot with an arrow and his sons are killed - He asks his armor bearer to kill him and when he would not, Saul fell on his own sword - The armor bearer killed himself as well - The Philistines took the bodies of Saul and sons and hung them on the walls of a city - The Israelites came and took them down, burned the bodies, and buried the bones - The men fasted for 7 days |
