<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - mocked more (Matt 27:27-31) - He was unable to carry the cross so Simon of Cyrene carried it behind Him to Golgatha (The Place of the Skull) - there was a crowd following Him (Luke 23:26-33) - two criminals with Him - give Him wine mixed with gall (myrrh) - bitter (poisonous) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - crucified Him with the criminals on either side - Father forgive them they don't know what they are doing (Luke 23:34) - casting lots for His clothing - sat down and watched (Matt 27:36) - sign - Jesus the Nazarene - The King of the Jews (John 19:19) - insults hurled at Him (Matt 27:39-44) - One of the robbers acknowledged who Jesus was with a repentant heart (Luke 23:39-43) - Women were at the cross weeping (John 19:25-27) - Jesus commends His mother to John's care 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 6th hour - darkness fell on the land until the 9th hour (Matt 27:45-50) - Jesus cries out, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?" - they offer Jesus sour wine and He takes that - Jesus, I am thirsty (John 19:28-30) - Jesus cried out, "It is finished!" - Jesus said, "Father into Thy hands, I commit My spirit" (Luke 23:46) - Jesus died

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the veil was split (Matt 27:51-56) - earth shook - tombs were open and the dead saints were walking around the city - The people around acknowledged that He was the Son of God - Centurion began praising God and saying that surely Jesus was innocent (Luke 23:47) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they wanted the bodies off the cross so they wouldn't have to stay there over the high Sabbath (John 19:31-38) - the Jews wanted to prepare - asked that the legs be broken - Jesus was already dead - they pierced His side - Joseph of Arimathea went to Pilate to ask for the body (Luke 23:50-52) - Pilate grants permission to remove the body (John 19:38) - Joseph and Nicodemus wrap the body and place it in a tomb 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - rolled the stone over the tomb - set a guard around it - set a seal on the rock (Matt 27:61-66) <p>guard = Roman guard was made up of 16 men</p> <p>each man had 6 square feet to guard</p> <p>they were not allowed to lean, sit, sleep</p> <p>if someone fell asleep - punishment was all would be killed</p>
