<p>Angel 1 - eternal gospel - Fear God, hour of His judgment has come, worship Him (not the beast) (6-7)</p> <p>Angel 2 - Fallen is Babylon the Great (world system)(8)</p> <p>Angel 3 - worship the beast - wrath of God - Lake of Fire (9-12)</p> <p>14-19 - put in the sickle and reap the grapes - put in the winepress of the wrath of God</p> <p>20 - trodden outside Jerusalem - the blood splatters or collects 4 feet for a distance of 200 miles</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Zech 14:1-5</li> <li>- Is 63:1-6 - starts in Bozrah (Edom)</li> <li>- Is 34:5-6</li> <li>- Joel 3:2 - valley of Jehoshaphat</li> <li>- Ez 39:8-16 - cleansing the land of the dead bodies</li> </ul>	<p>7 angels - 7 plagues which are the last - in them the wrath of God is finished</p> <p>There are those who will overcome the beast and his image and his mark - they will be singing praises to God</p> <p>7 angels came out of the temple - one of the living creatures gave them 7 bowls</p> <p>Temple was filled with smoke and no one could enter until the 7 plagues were finished</p>	<p>Bowl 1 - sores</p> <p>Bowl 2 - sea becomes blood</p> <p>Bowl 3 - water becomes blood</p> <p>Bowl 4 - sun scorches man</p> <p>Bowl 5 - beast's kingdom is darkened and they gnaw their tongue in pain</p> <p>Bowl 6 - Euphrates dries up and the kings gather at Har-Magedon</p> <p>Bowl 7 - IT IS DONE - wrath of God has been poured out on sin - judgment is about to be complete - lightning thunder, earthquake, city splits in 3, cities of the nations fell - Babylon was remembered, islands/mountains gone, huge hailstones (100 lbs)</p>

<p>Babylon remember</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 17:1-7 - description of Babylon</li> <li>- 17:8-14 - meaning of the description</li> <li>- 17:15-18 - beast and the kings want to destroy Babylon</li> <li>- 18:1-3 - Immorality of Babylon</li> <li>- 18:4-8 - pride, sins piled up to heaven</li> <li>- 18:9-10 - kings mourn her</li> <li>- 18:11-20 - merchants mourn her</li> <li>- 18:21-24 - thrown down in violence</li> </ul>	<p>Praise to the Father and the Son (1-10)</p> <p>Marriage of the Lamb (7-10)</p> <p>Jesus comes to smite the nations - treading the winepress (11-16)</p> <p>Supper of God (17-18) - the birds ate the flesh of those who were killed</p> <p>Beast and false prophet were thrown into the Lake of Fire (20)</p>	<p>Millennial Kingdom</p> <p>Satan is bound and put in the abyss for 1,000 years (1-3)</p> <p>Jesus comes to reign on earth - rule with a rod of iron (19:15) - the church will rule with Him as well as those who did not receive the mark of the beast (4-6)</p> <p>Rest of the dead did not come to life until the end of the 1,000 years (5)</p> <p>1,000 year reign</p> <p>Satan is released - and he deceives the nations (7-8) - like the sands of the seashore</p> <p>They gathered in a broad plain they surround the camp of the saints and Jerusalem</p> <p>Fire comes from heaven and devours</p> <p>Satan goes to the Lake of Fire</p> <p>Great White Throne Judgment - rest of the dead appear and are judged according to their deeds - they will be thrown in the Lake of Fire</p>	<p>New Heaven</p> <p>New Earth</p> <p>New Jerusalem</p> <p>IT IS DONE (21:6) - all things have been made new</p>
