<p>he obeyed Jesus</p> <p>this is the man who is called Jesus - he anointed my eyes and I saw</p> <p>Jesus is a prophet</p> <p>If this man was not from God, He could not do these things</p> <p>He believed and worshipped Him</p>	<p>blindness was for those to see the will of God done in his life</p> <p>He is the Son of Man, Light of the World, He has the power to heal</p> <p>For judgment He came into this world that the blind might see and the seeing would be blind</p> <p>He points to the Pharisees and tells them that they are blind or if they "see" then they are in sin</p>	<p>this is our son</p> <p>he was born blind</p> <p>go talk to him</p> <p>they were afraid of the Jews and that they would be put out of the synagogue</p>	<p>Amazed, shocked, unbelief</p> <p>they take him to the Pharisees</p> <p>question the man again</p>	<p>it was a Sabbath day</p> <p>Jesus is not from God because He doesn't keep the Sabbath</p> <p>how could a sinner perform these signs?</p> <p>brought in the parents</p> <p>they had already agreed that any who confessed Jesus to be Christ would be put out of the synagogue</p> <p>they accuse the blind man of being a sinner yet trying to teach them</p> <p>put the man out of the synagogue</p> <p>confront Jesus - and say they are not blind</p>
