<p>1-5</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - glorify the Son (1) so the Son can glorify the Father - God gave the believers to Jesus that He (Jesus) could give them eternal life (2) - eternal life comes from knowing God and Jesus Christ who God had sent (3) - Jesus accomplished the work the Father had given Him (4) - both Jesus and the Father would be glorified in what Jesus was about to do (5) 	<p>6-19</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - God gave Jesus these men (6) - These men have kept God's Word (6) - they received Jesus' words and understood them - believed that Jesus came from God and was sent by God (8) - Jesus asks on the disciples behalf (9, 10) - He asks that they be kept in Their name while they are in the world (11) - Jesus was keeping them and guarding them (12) - not one of them perished except the son of perdition (12) - His joy to be made full in them (13) - they would be kept from the evil one (15) even though they are in the world - He did not ask them to be taken out of the world (15) - sanctify them in the truth - Thy Word is truth (17) 	<p>20-26</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus' word, the disciples words come down to us so that we might believe that Jesus is the Christ (20) - we will be one with God (21) - the world will believe when they see God in us (21) - perfect in unity that the world would know that God sent Jesus (23) - that we can see (behold) His glory (24) - they will know that God sent Jesus (25) - Jesus causes us to know God (26) - Love of God is us and Jesus is in us (26)
