<p>When will the temple be torn down? (24:3)</p> <p>What will be the sign of Your coming and the end of the age?</p> <p>Coming = 2nd coming</p> <p>Wars, famines, earthquakes, betrayal, you will be delivered up on account of me, false prophets, people's love will grow cold</p> <p>When you see the Abomination of Desolation as spoken by Daniel - flee</p> <p>Great tribulation (24:21) - everyone will know - last 3 1/2 years of Daniel's 70th week</p> <p>Immediately after the tribulation of those days the Son of Man will come (24:29-31)</p> <p>Judgment (25:31-46)</p>	<p>Triumphal Entry of Jesus</p> <p>Going to Jerusalem for the final time</p> <p>Sent 2 disciples to get a colt of a donkey that has never been ridden</p> <p>Jesus weeps over the city - because they did not understand his first coming and its purpose (41-42)</p> <p>43</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - days will come when your enemies will throw up a barricade against you - Surround you and hem you in - Level you to the ground and your children within you - Will not leave one stone upon another - because they did not recognize the time of their visitation (44) - 70 AD Titus's destruction <p>45-48 - trying to destroy Jesus - looking for any opportunity</p>	<p>Teaching at the temple and the chief priests, scribes, and elders asked Jesus by whose authority He has come (1-8)</p> <p>Parable of the vine-growers (9-18)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Jesus tells this parable to all the people - Vineyard owner will send His beloved Son (Jesus) - Kill the Son so the inheritance would be theirs - What will the owner of the vineyard do? - He will come and destroy the vine-growers (the people of the vineyard = Jews) - destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD - Vineyard will be given to others - Gentile nations (Rome and then others) - MAY IT NEVER BE! - the people were angry because they understood what Jesus saying - Scribes and chief priests - tribute money - Sadducees - Question the resurrection - Jesus questions the people

<p>Widow's gift (1-4)</p> <p>Jesus statement (5-6)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the days are coming that this will all be torn down <p>Disciples Question (7-9)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - when will these things happen? - What will be the sign that these things are about to take place? - See to it that you are not misled - Many will come in my name - Hear about wars and disturbances - don't be terrified <p>BUT BEFORE ALL THESE THINGS (12)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - lay hands on you, persecute you, deliver you to prison, bringing you before kings (12) - It will lead to an opportunity for your testimony (13) - Don't prepare to defend yourselves - for I will give you the words that no one will be able to refute (14-15) - Being betrayed by those close to you - Some will be put to death - Hated for the name of Jesus - Not a hair of your head will perish 	<p>Jerusalem will be surrounded by armies - recognize that her desolation is near</p> <p>Those in Judea must flee to the mountains - these are days of vengeance</p> <p>Great distress upon the land and wrath to this people (Jews)</p> <p>Fall by the edge of the sword</p> <p>Led captive into all the nations</p> <p>Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles UNTIL</p> <p>THE TIMES OF THE GENTILES ARE FULFILLED</p>	<p>AFTER THE TIMES OF THE GENTILES ARE FULFILLED</p> <p>(8-11 - describe what happens after the time of the Gentiles)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - signs in the sun, moon, stars - Dismay in the nations - Perplexity at the roaring of the seas - Men fainting from fear - The powers of heaven will be shaken <p>THEN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with power and great glory - When these things happen - redemption is drawing close <p>Parable of the Fig Tree</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - when you see these things happening recognize that the kingdom of God is near - This generation will not pass away until all things take place <p>BE ON GUARD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - hearts not weighted down with drunkenness and worries of life - Being alert and in prayer watching for the day so that you. May be saved
